
Presentation to West Area Forum

Area is largely rural and communities are small and widespread





2009-2010 Performance

- Uttlesford a Low Crime Area with 12.9 Crimes per 1000 residents against a force average of 15
- Sits centrally within the family of similar CSPs nationally (lowest being 9.7, highest being 19.1)
