The decision is considered to be urgent because:

The reason this decision is urgent and cannot wait 28 days is that the Council wishes to act quickly so we can benefit struggling businesses and if we wait 28 days there is an increased risk of business failure and there is already a backlog of applications because earlier government funding streams have run out – one likely option is that we will use the funding to help clear this backlog.
