To confirm how Essex County Council and the Essex Children's Safeguarding Board propose to respond to any ongoing concerns about the level of safeguarding for children in the county. To consider level of compliance with Lord Laming's second report (published in the light of the Climbie case and other subsequent concerns in England and Wales)
