The reason for the decision being urgent is that we need to put arrangements to spend the money quickly in order to continue to support the sector. The money was only announced recently £7 billion for NHS and social care for COVID-19 response and recovery - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) and replaces funding streams which expire on 31 March 2021. Although full details of the funding have not yet been received we anticipate, based on previous announcements, that the Council will be expected to put spending arrangements in place very quickly.
