Title of Decision	New pre application tree assessment charge for vehicle crossover applications where there is a Highways tree within 15 metres and a charge for replacement tree planting if removal is required
Brief summary of the issue to be decided	Essex County Council (ECC) has a responsibility to manage and maintain all trees across the Highways. ECC is also responsible for granting residents' consent to cross the Highway network via vehicle crossovers in order to access their properties. Presently the vehicle crossover application process does not suitably consider the presence of trees, which make an increasingly important contribution to the appearance of an area and are a vital resource in helping to achieve Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 set in law. The proposal is to: • establish a chargeable pre application tree assessment service to residents that integrates with the existing vehicle crossover application process, so that the impact of any applications
	where there is a tree within 15m of a proposed crossover can be fully assessed at the outset, before the application has been submitted charge for replacement tree planting if removal is required to support a vehicle crossing installation.
