



## **Operation targets** London criminals

Joint action with Met brings eight arrests in a night Natalie Hoodless

editorial@gazettenews.co.uk EIGHT suspected criminals were arrested during the latest assault on burglars attracted to Brentwood by its affluence. In the first-ever joint operation

between Essex Police and the Met, patrols marked the routes in and out of the town on Monday night as they looked out for the mos wanted criminals.

Attracted

Brentwood Borough Commander Chief Insp Keith Dobson said: Most of the criminals we arrest live in the Met Police area, they are largely attracted by Brentwood's affluence.

"People here tend to have high value cars and that is appealing or the criminals."

A rogues gallery of eight pro lific offenders was handed to the 50 officers taking part in Operation Rodney, as the exercise was amed

Chief Insp Dobson said: "It hasn't come as a surprise that a number of the Havering criminals are known to Essex Police.
