
# A&E Performance – Southend University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust











- Overall growth in A&E attendances of 3,601 (3.56%) in 2018/19 compared to 2017/18
- Each Quarter 2018/19 saw • Year on Year growth in A&E attendances (Q1=2.51%; Q2=3.96%; Q3=0.96%; Q4=6.96%).
- Q1 2019/20 has seen Year on • Year growth of 2.95% and 5.54% growth compared to Q1 17/18.
- There were 23,445 NEL • Admissions in 2017/18 (conversion rate of 23.2%) compared to 22,982 in 2018/19 (conversion rate of 21.96%).

 In the period Nov 18 – Jun 19 ED attendances increased by 2,793 (4.13%) compared to Nov 17 – Jun 18


 In the same period, Majors attendances reduced by 6,446 (26.32%)

#### A&E Developments / Actions Southend University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

- Workforce workforce plan has been completed and is currently being reviewed by the Site Leadership Team. The plan recommends a further 2 A&E Consultant posts; and an increase in both triage nursing and minors nursing establishment. The workforce plan has been reviewed and is supported by ECIST.
- Social Worker at the Front Door this post has been in place for since winter 2018 and has demonstrated a poistive contribution in relation to admission avoidance.
- SDEC 31% of current NEL take is admitted via SDEC (NHSI target is to achieve 30% by end March 2020). Project Group is in place to deliver an ambitious target of 50% by end 2020.
- Teletracking commissioned in October 2018 has resulted in improved transparency of bed capacity and utilisation leading to improved patient flow across site.

#### **GP Streaming** – Southend University Hospital Foundation Trust

- 21.3% (5,766 patients) of all A&E attendances were streamed to GP Streaming in Q1 2019/20 which makes Southend the second highest user of GP Streaming in East of England Region.
- The service operates from 08:00 to midnight, 7-days per week with a planned roster of two GP's per shift.
- The shift fill rate for Q1 is 99.73% (April 96.25%; May 103%; June 100%).
- Performance data is collected daily and from this we are aware that 21.8% of those patients referred to GP Streaming are referred back to hospital for specialist review which is not too dissimilar to the conversion rate to hospital admission from A&E.
- We are planning a local clinical audit to ascertain what is informing this level of refer-back and to understand whether there need to be changes made to our clinical criteria and initial streaming processes at the front door.

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
