One consideration of this measure is that it is dependent not just on the number of re- offences due to alcohol or drugs in the period, but on the corresponding frequency of offending in general by which proportionality is measured. In particular, quarter 3 returned a lower than usual frequency of overall offending activity (which in itself is good news) combined with a slightly greater frequency of re-offending in relation to specified offences involving alcohol or drugs. This unfortunate combination of higher numerator and lower denominator created a spike in quarter 3 which eventually contributed to our narrowly missing this target. All young people are assessed for substance use, and where there are problems, speedy referrals to EYPDAS are carried out as a matter of course.	Although this has now ended, our core work continues to deal with substance use and its associated problems. Each team has a dedicated EYPDAS worker embedded within it, in addition to mental health practitioners.
