1 Membership, Apologies, Substitutions and Declarations of Interest

The Chairman explained the reasons for the "in person" meeting and advised of the intention for alternate meetings to be held online,

2 Minutes of the previous meeting

The Minutes of the meeting held on 11 May 2023 were approved as a correct record.

3 Introduction to the Essex Flood Partnership Board

The Board received an update from John Meehan, Head of Climate Adaptation & Mitigation, regarding the role of the Essex Flood Partnership Board.

John Meehan explained that as there were a number of new members present and this was the first "face to face" meeting since the pandemic, he felt that it seemed appropriate to remind members of the great track record of the Essex Flood Board. The Board was set up after the Flood and Water Management Act 2010. He also reminded the Board that they also fit within the Regional Flood and Coastal Committees (RFCC). The RFCC which covers most of Essex is the Anglian Eastern RFCC, which has four Essex County Council (ECC) members, one Thurrock Council member and a Southend on Sea City Council member. There is also a single ECC member on the Great Ouse RFCC and the Thames RFCC's.

John also stated that he wanted to emphasise that the Board has a good relationship with the Environment Agency, whose officers were present at the meeting and that has unlocked £80.7 million from grants between 2015 and 2023.

The Chairman offered his thanks to all the officers involved in supporting the Board. He stressed the importance of the Board and was grateful for all those that were in attendance.

4 Climate Czar role and Autumn Climate Summit

Johan Meehan advised that Cllr Peter Schwier ECC Climate Czar and Cabinet Member for Waste Reduction and Recycling, had unfortunately been called away at very short notice to attend an Environment Committee at the House of Commons.

John advised that Cllr Schwier would have invited the Flood Board Members to the Essex Autumn Climate Conference which was being held on 31st October at the County Hotel, from 10am -1 pm. Following the meeting the contact details of Board members were shared with Louise Tennekoon, Climate Action Engagement Manager who would arrange for invites to be sent.

5 National Flood Risk Assessment 2 (NaFRA2)

The Board received a presentation from Michael White (Environment Agency) in relation to the National Flood Risk Assessment 2 (NaFRA2) update being undertaken.

Issues raised by Members included:

- Implications of planning applications close to flood plains- it was confirmed that the key issue is to take into consideration all the relevant available data.
- Importance of tapping into the knowledge of local residents and action groups this was acknowledge as being of importance.
- Concerns regarding the maintenance of assets it was confirmed that where there was awareness of changes, new data would be obtained.
- In response to a Member question, it was confirmed that this was a "live" document which could be added/fed into.
- Whether it could model flood plain mapping- clarification was given that local mapping could be used to assist
- Mapping of "protected areas" it was confirmed that going forward this should be improved.

John Meehan advised that the ECC Flood team have done significant work regarding modelling. Dave Chapman expanded upon this and confirmed that relevant date would be shared with the Environment Agency.

6 2023/24 Essex Capital Flood Programme update

The Board received a report, **(EFPB/04/23)** Essex Capital Flood Programme update, from Dave Chapman, Project Delivery Manager, on the progress of schemes in the Floods Capital Programme.

Some Members enquired regarding projects within their Districts, with Dave and relevant officers giving an update accordingly.

The Board noted the report.

7 Anglian Water Update

Jonathan Glerum, Anglian Water (AW) gave an update presentation regarding AW. The presentation included background information and an overview which Jonathan felt would be particularly useful for new Board members, stressing the importance of partnership working.
