



FRMP products/ tools

- Measures development guidance released 13 August
- Live measures development tool released 13 August
- Final Objectives released 16 July
- National once measures LLFA final released 16 September and EA draft released 7 August
- FRMP template internal and external released 21 August



FRMP approvals

- By mid Jan 2021, measures development freeze
 - EA AFCRM and equivalent within LLFA
- Before draft documents are finalised for consultation
 - Currently considering two options for EA approval
 - LLFA approval will probably vary between LLFAs may be Cabinet Member/ Full Cabinet / Overview and Scrutiny Committee
