Purpose of Report

To advise the Executive Scrutiny Committee of the work that has been undertaken by other Policy and Scrutiny Committees in relation to the Transformation Programme.

Children and Young People Policy and Scrutiny Committee

This Committee received a briefing at its 7 January 2010 meeting by Wendi Ogle-Welbourn, Director for Commissioning, entitled 'New Schools, Children and Families Directorate Structure'.

A further presentation was received on 6 January 2011 from Councillor Candy, Cabinet Member for Children's Services, Dave Hill, Executive Director for Schools, Children and Families, and Wendi Ogle-Welbourn, Director for Commissioning around the changing structure of governance arrangements for Children's Services.

At its meeting on 12 May 2011, Councillor Candy and Wendi Ogle-Welbourn provided an update on the future commissioning of mainstream residential care.

Community and Older People Policy and Scrutiny Committee

This Committee received a presentation at its 9 December meeting around the future proposals for delivering services and the Target Operating Model for the Adults, Health and Community Wellbeing Directorate.

Economic Development, Environment and Highways and Policy and Scrutiny Committee

In March 2011 (Minute 13) the former Economic Development and Environment Policy and Scrutiny Committee considered the Highways Strategic Transformation Programme, and agreed that it be afforded the opportunity to consider the final contract in more detail at the appropriate time. The new Committee will be including this matter in its Forward Look.
