

Notice of a proposal to take a Key Decision
without it having been on the forward plan for 28 clear days

To Chairman of Corporate Policy and Scrutiny Committee

This is to formally notify you that it is proposed to take the following decision:

Adult Social Care – Proposal for Domiciliary Care Providers

The decision relates a proposal to agree that the Council will put temporary arrangements so that domiciliary care providers are paid even if they don't provide care – but only if the reason for this is a result of staff having to isolate.

It also proposes to pay for care where a carer arranged by a recipient of direct payments is unable to provide care.

These will result in a cost to the council where service users currently pay some or all of the cost of their care – because we are unable to charge service users for care not delivered.

The decision asks for £2.5m the allocated to meet the costs.

It is proposed that the decision will be taken by:

Cllr Bentley or Cllr Spence

The decision is considered to be urgent because:

The reason for the decision being urgent is that we need to put arrangements to spend the money quickly in order to respond to the 'pingdemic' and reassure providers.

It is proposed that the decision will be taken not less than five clear days from the date this notice was given to you. A copy of this notice will be placed on the Council's website.
