

- Enabling right sized and right quality business accommodation to generate grow on space




REDUCING DEPRIVATION AND INEQUALITY

Future Growth And Investment

We will help grow the economic sectors of the future in Essex, including the arts, secure high levels of new investment and grow existing businesses by working with partners to promote the County and create the conditions for growth and retain public sector spend within the county.



Green Growth

We will develop Essex as a centre for innovation, supporting new technologies and business models to support our economy to transition to net zero and secure green jobs for the future by ensuring we have the right local skills and drawing in investment opportunities.



Infrastructure

We will deliver high quality infrastructure to improve opportunities for people living in Essex as well as supporting a growing economy and the delivery of new homes and communities by investing in excess of £1bn by the end of this Council.



Good Jobs
