In 2007 Day Services gratefully received a bequest from Mrs Ellen Barber. Staff took a vote and it was decided the money would be used to benefit customers with dementia.


Reminiscence Therapy and Memory Boxes

Much research has been undertaken to identify the benefits of using reminiscence therapy, these benefits include improved communication, reduction in symptoms of depression and improved quality of life. People with dementia can often recall past events better than recent events.

Having familiar objects around can be reassuring and can stimulate memory recollection from the distant past.

Reminiscence Therapy uses music to sing along to, conversation, quizzes, familiar objects and pictures from the past.

Reminiscence is usually cumulative, which means that one memory leads to another. And now we have the Memory Box Project.
