

Notice of a proposal to take a Key Decision

This is to formally notify you that it is proposed to take the following decision:

Winter Discharge Funding Care Providers

As you may have heard the Government announced a new funding stream yesterday called the Winter Discharge Fund. ECC will receive £4.9m directly and may receive significant other funding via the NHS.

This notice is that not less than five clear days from this letter (ie not before 28 November 2022) the Council will take a key decision, which is not on the forward plan, on how to spend this money.

It is proposed that the decision will be taken by:

Cllr Bentley or Cllr John Spence

The decision is considered to be urgent because:

We need to decide urgently how to spend the money on increasing care capacity and making it easier or more attractive for providers to take packages of care of people who are being discharged from hospital.

It is proposed that the decision will be taken not less than five clear days from the date this notice was given to you. A copy of this notice will be placed on the Council's website.
