Title of Decision	New Section 75 Partnership Agreement with Essex Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust for Mental Health Social Work.
Brief summary of the issue to be decided	The Council's duties under the Care Act 2014 for residents of Essex with mental health needs have been delegated to the NHS under Section 75 of the NHS Act 2006. These duties are currently carried out on the Council's behalf by Essex Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust ("the Trust"). The existing Partnership Agreement expires on 30th September 2022. Therefore, agreement is sought to enter into a new, Section 75 Partnership Agreement with the Trust for a period of up to 30 months to 31st March 2025 (with the option to extend for up to a further six months). During which time a full review and redesign of mental health social work will continue to be undertaken; to be delivered in tandem with the NHS England Community Mental Health Transformation Programme, and ASC Place based working model are already underway.
