Proposed Changes to Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions – Victoria Road, Chelmsford.

We wish to inform you of the proposed changes to restrictions in Victoria Road, in Chelmsford.

Background: The new development located on the northern side of Victoria Road has been granted permission to install a vehicular access. It is therefore necessary to remove the existing Limited Waiting restrictions at this location to ensure visibility is maintained for vehicles using the new access. As part of the works the existing layby will be removed and footway/kerb will be reinstated.

The provision of a Goods Vehicle Loading bay is intended to serve the ground floor commercial units of the development. The existing footway/kerb is to be moved to allow for the Goods Vehicle Loading to be located within a designated layby ensuring the visibility is kept clear and without obstructing the movement of vehicles using Victoria Road.

Further details: The drawing which accompanies this letter illustrates the proposal. Public Notices advertising the proposal will also be placed on nearby street furniture e.g. posts or columns.
