Summary of Outcomes

- Review identified Trust had already made a number of quality improvements since the change of leadership in 2010
- Trust staff were committed and enthusiastic
- Trust recognised the issues and the need to increase the pace of change





Summary of Urgent Actions

- Development and embedding of clear and comprehensive Quality Strategy
- Staffing review in high risk wards
- Ownership amongst medical staff for deteriorating patients
- Clinical leadership (both medical and nursing)





Trust Response

- Presentation to the Risk summit on board focus summary
 - Commitment to act on priorities improve patient care
 - Next Phase of Improvement
 - Workforce that is committed, caring and motivated
- Action plan agreed





Monitoring Arrangements

- CCG leading monitoring of action plan
- CHUFT very robust internal process for monitoring delivery – CCG involvement
- CCG and CHUFT executive teams meeting fortnightly with agreed terms of reference
- Quality Surveillance Group receiving updates from CCG





Update on Action Plan

- CCG has received assurance that CHUFT are on target to achieve all key actions within plan
- CCG receives updated action plan fortnightly
- CCG has been invited to be part of internal assurance process within CHUFT
