<b>Title of Decision</b>	Concessionary Fares Settlement 2022/23
<b>Brief summary of the issue to be decided</b>	The English National Concessionary Travel Scheme (ENCTS) legislation requires each Travel Concession Authority (TCA) to have a concessionary bus pass scheme in place by 1 March before the start of each financial year. This decision paper will authorise officers to enter into negotiations with commercial bus operators over the settlement of the 2022/2023 concessionary fare scheme, sets out the options open to the County Council in pursuing the negotiations and (in the confidential appendix) the parameters within which such negotiations will take place.
