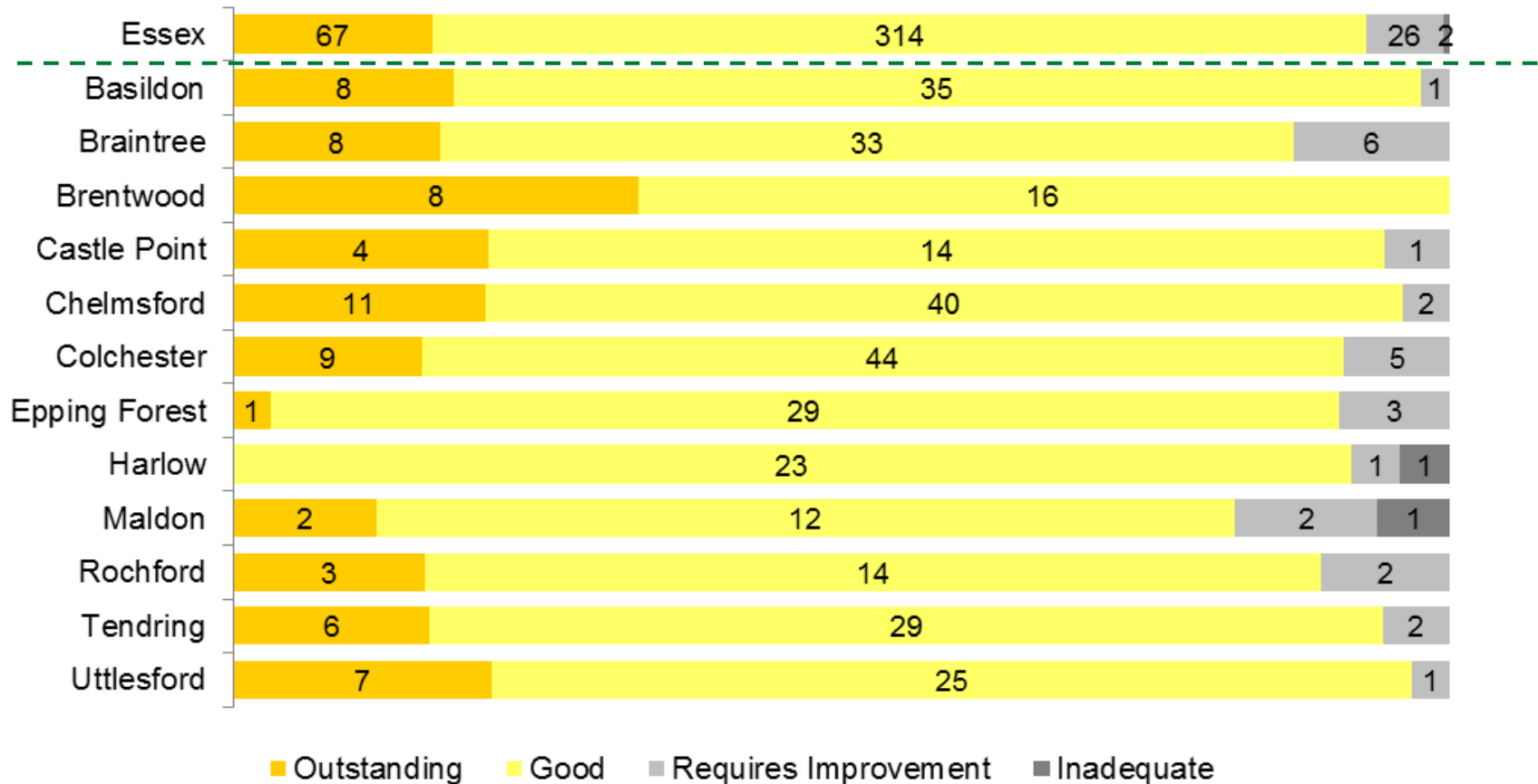

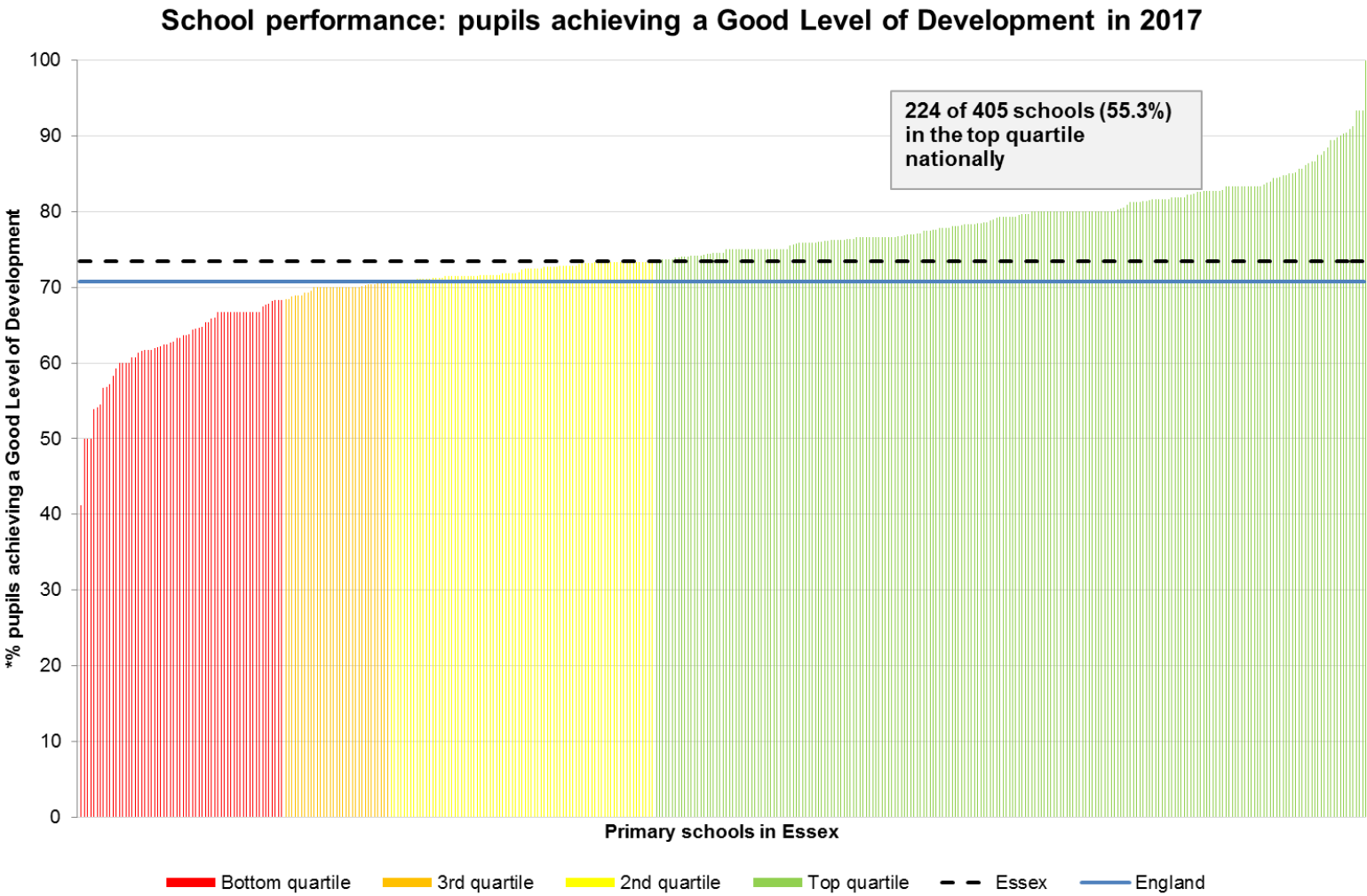

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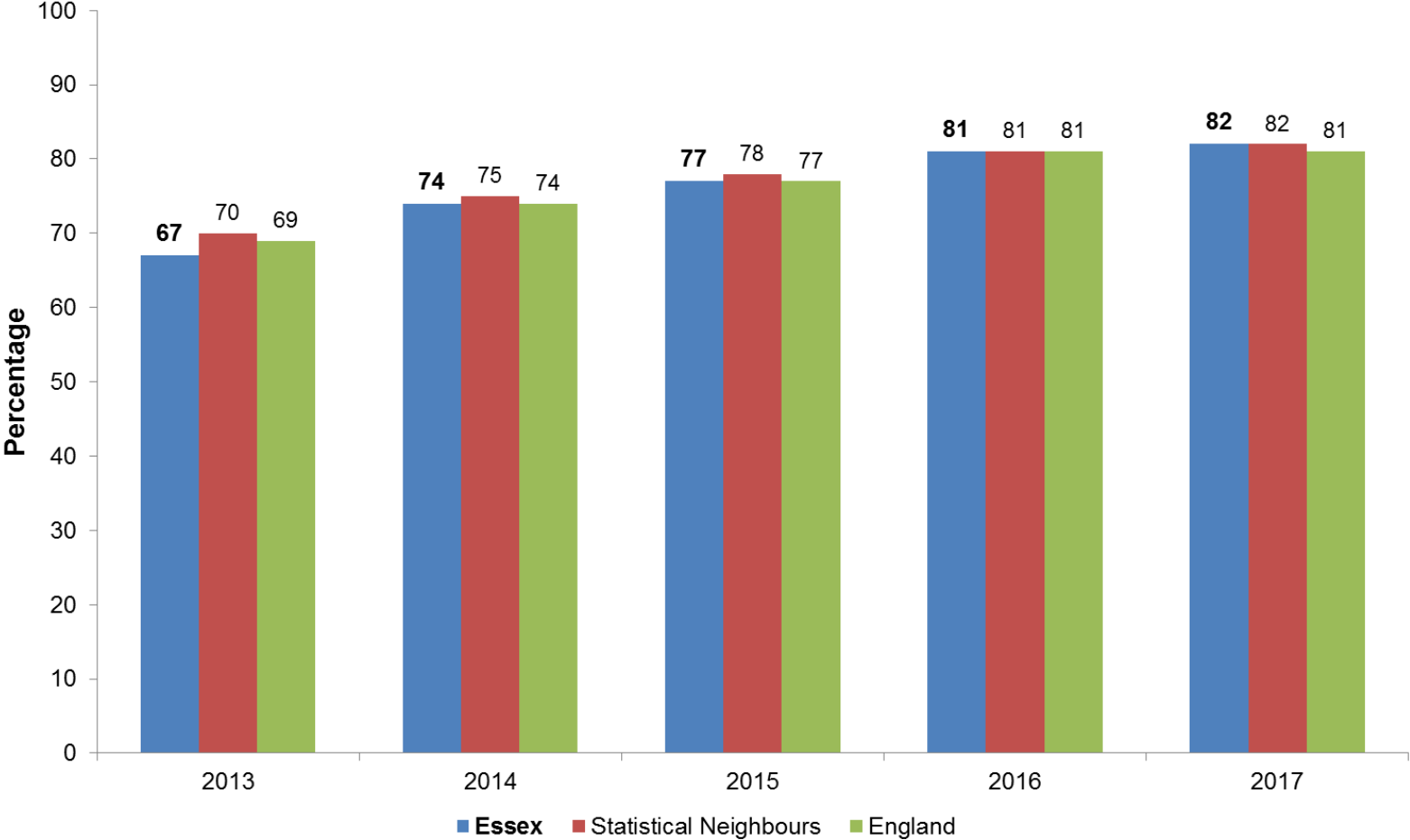

2013-2017



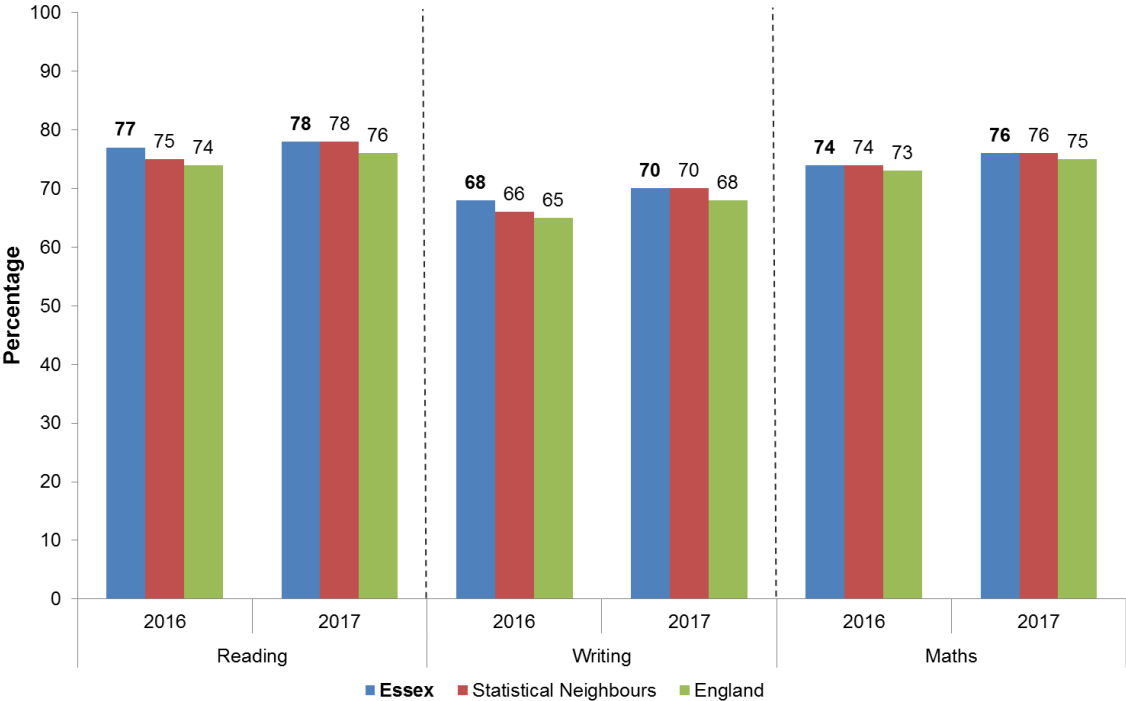

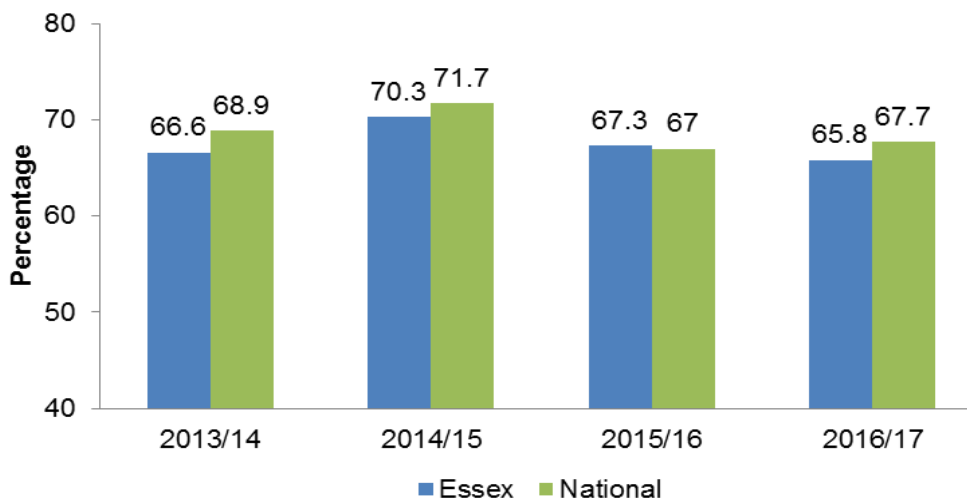

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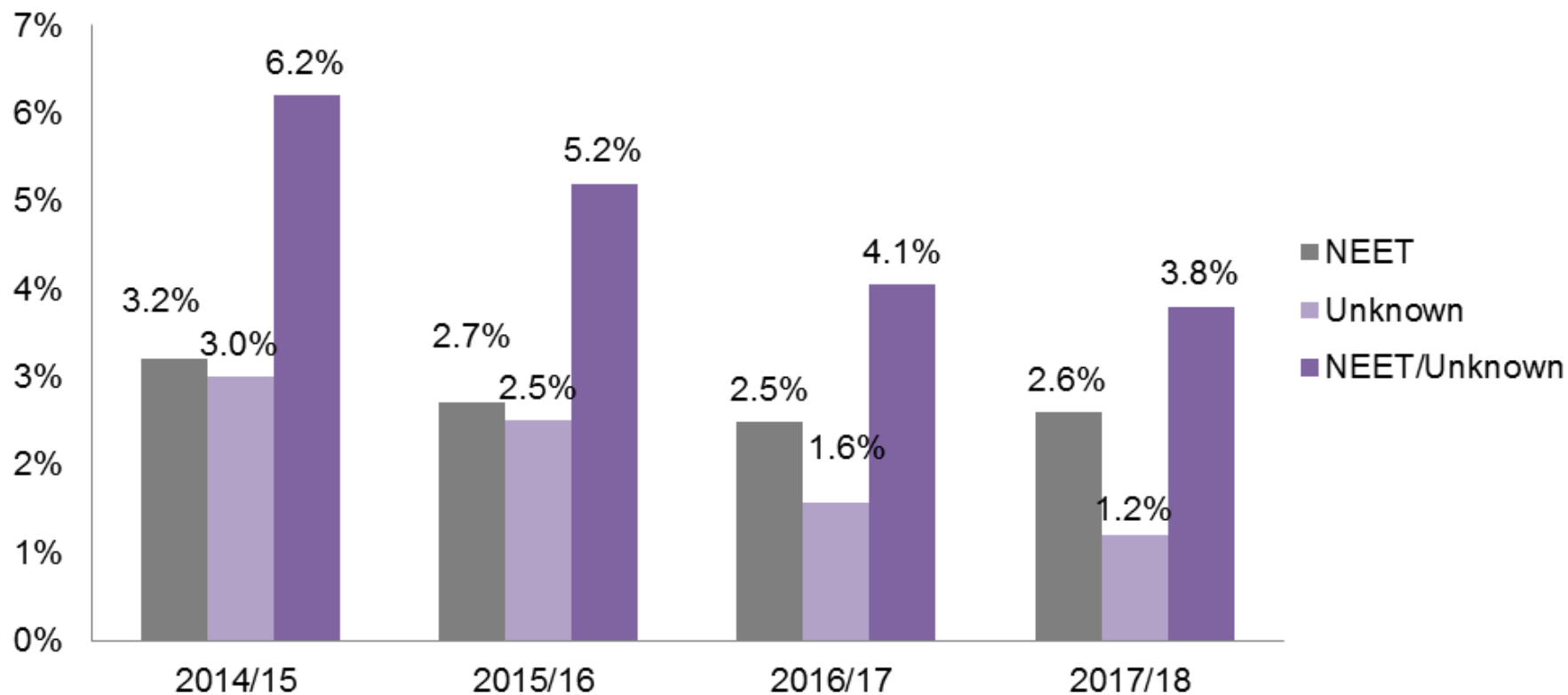
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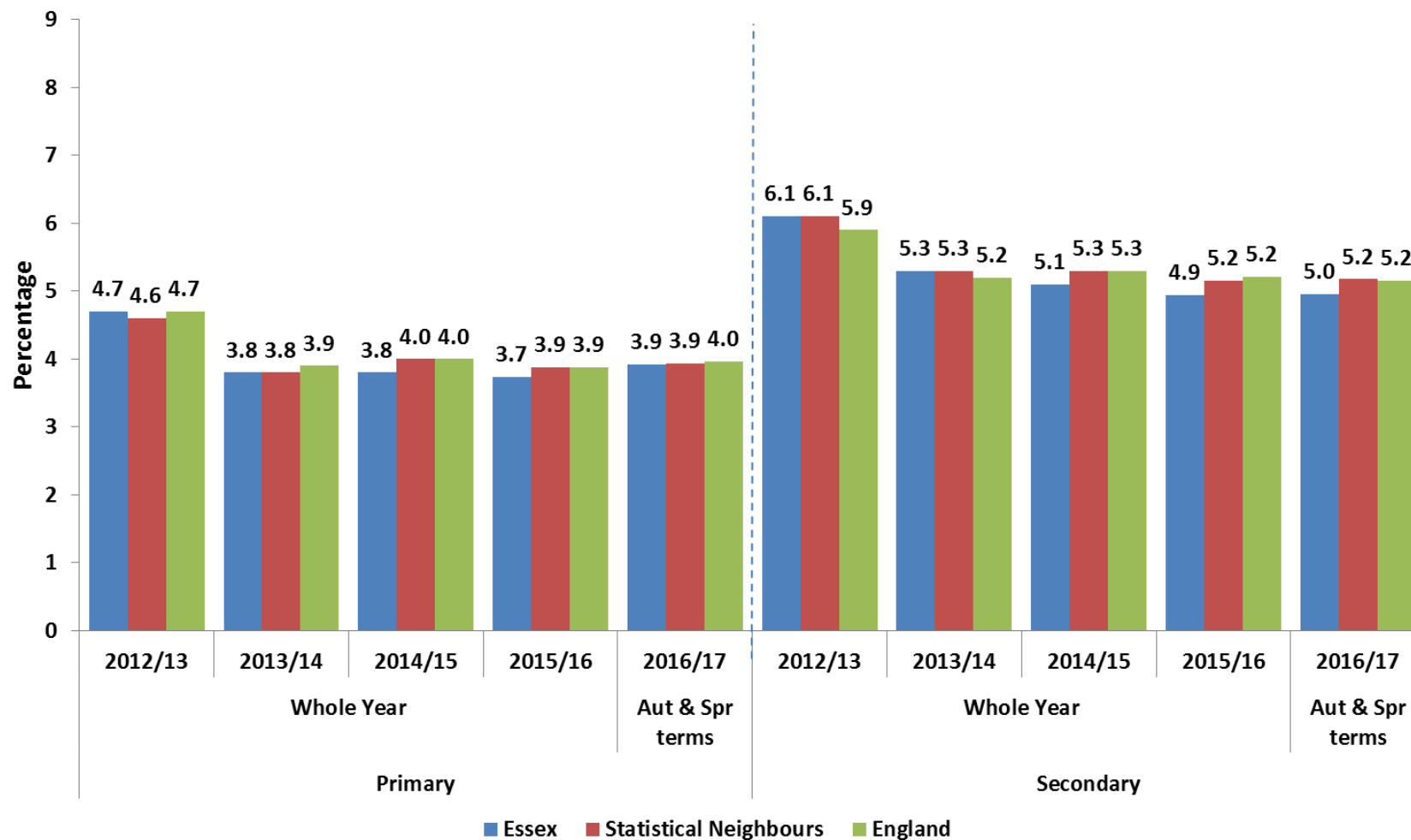


## Percentage 16 and 17 year olds NEET or whose activity is unknown (2014/15 - 2017/18)



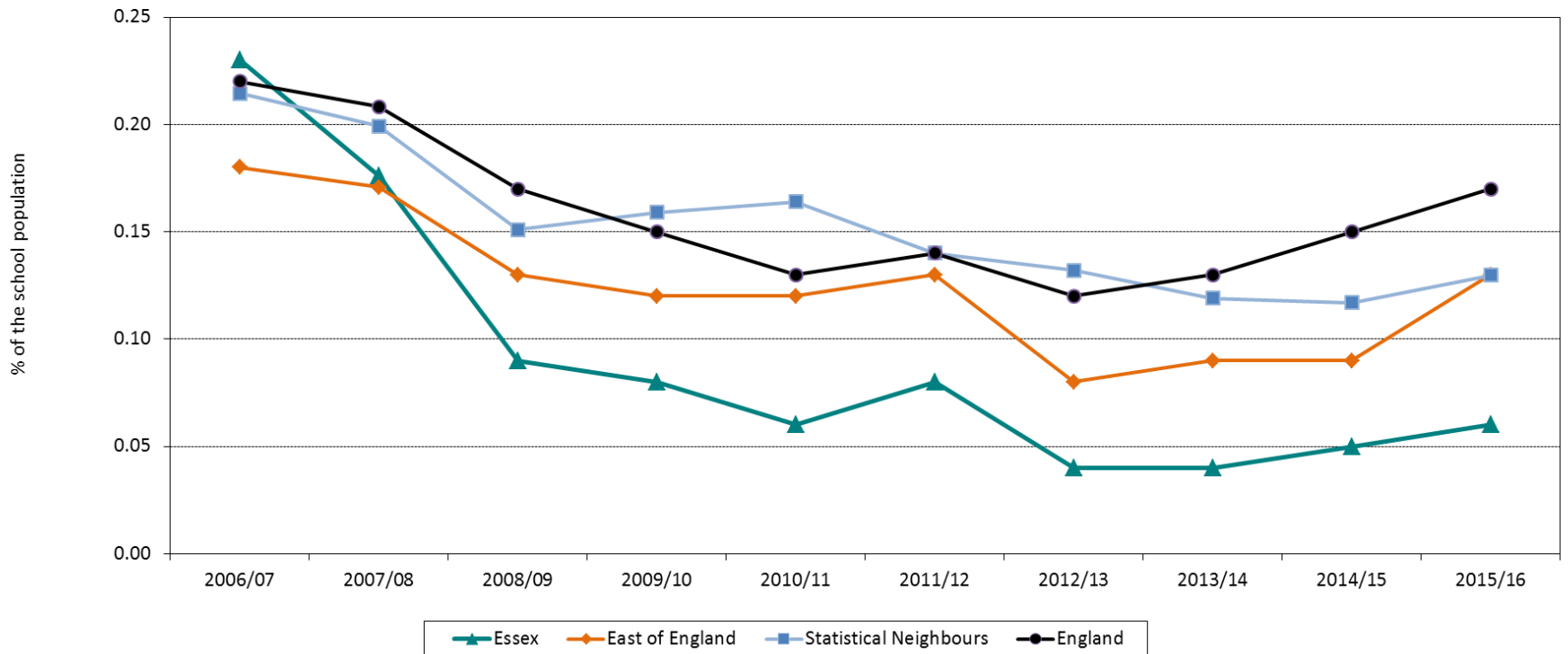
# Absence and exclusions: Overall absence

2012/13 - 2016/17 (Autumn & Spring terms)













