Executive summary

Title of policy or decision: Education Transport Contingency Fund

Describe the main aims, objectives and purpose of the policy (or decision): Schools and educational settings in Essex will reopen in September and welcome back all children since the Covid-19 closures began. ECC is required to provide all eligible children in Essex with transport to a school or an educational setting.

Education Transport is provided for eligible pupils in Essex to their form of education (mainstream schools, special schools and alternative educational settings). DfE guidance has set a new framework for supporting transport to and from schools from the autumn term 2020.

The proposal is that statutory Education Transport continues to be delivered within existing budgetary envelope and contractual costs in line with DfE guidance.

For exceptional cases, such as specific Covid 19 related medical risks, where ECC cannot deliver the necessary level of service within existing contract costs and budgetary envelope, ECC will establish a contingency fund of £500,000.

This decision asks Cllr Whitbread to approve a drawdown of £500,000 from the General balance for the provision of statutory Education Transport.

The drawdown will fund Education Transport in exceptional cases where we cannot deliver the necessary level of service for children entitled to home to school transport ("entitled children") within existing contract costs due to the impacts of the Covid -19 pandemic and there is no better value for money alternative provision.
