I am writing to inform you that it is proposed to take a key decision which is not on the forward plan and we are likely to ask you to exempt from call in too.

Details of the decision are below. It is a follow on the previous one relating to distribution of funding to care homes.

Decision title	Particulars of decision and why it is impracticable to wait 28 days
Adult Social Care - Infection Control Fund, round 2 allocation	Councils have been allocated a second round of funding to be passported to the market for Infection control measures. This fund is for measures between 1 October and 31 March 2021. The first tranche of monies was received on 2 October 2020 and the guidance stipulates that these monies should be with providers within 20 days of receiving the funds. If we wait the 28 days usually required for the forward plan we would not be able to adhere to this part of the guidance.
