- To grant funding to the Essex Association of Local Councils to support mutual aid groups in their response to the COVID outbreak. The funding shall be distributed by the Essex Association of Local Councils in accordance with criteria set by the Council.
- 3. To grant funding, to be distributed directly by the Council, to medium sized third sector organisations working on the frontline to meet increased demand for services from COVID-19.
- 4. To grant funding to 11 Volunteer Centres in Essex to support the volunteer centre network.
- To vary an existing contract with Provide CIC to include additional administration services to support the Volunteering Tactical Coordination Group.
- 6. To make a payment to the Essex Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust, the Mid and South Essex NHS Foundation Trust and the East Suffolk and North East Essex NHS Foundation Trust to support projects such as transport to vaccination appointments, campaigns to encourage take-up of the vaccine and supporting patients to self-isolate.
- 7. To vary an existing contract with Essex Cares Limited to include additional services to support those with sensory needs.
- 8. For officers to agree the terms of the grant criteria to be applied above, the terms of which shall be consistent with the COMF national guidelines.
