'This Council celebrates the news that three of its Housing and Infrastructure Fund bids (HIFs) to Government have been successful. This recognises the Council's great work in unlocking economic growth which in turn will provide jobs, homes, improvements to future transportation needs and the chance for existing and new families to prosper. Essex is a leading County in economic growth and we now call

As the Essex Economic Commission showed in its 2017 report, the county's economy has poor skills levels and low productivity. In 2016, a significantly lower proportion of Essex adults (aged 16 – 64) have skills at Levels 3 and 4 with 53% and 32%, respectively, compared to 57% and 38% nationally. And with low productivity, the county's economy is falling behind its peers. Between 2006 and 2015, Essex GDP per person has fallen from 99% of the EU average, while London has grown from 503% to 580%. This Council therefore calls on the Government to join ECC in investing in our other growth corridors of the M11, the A127 and A13.'
