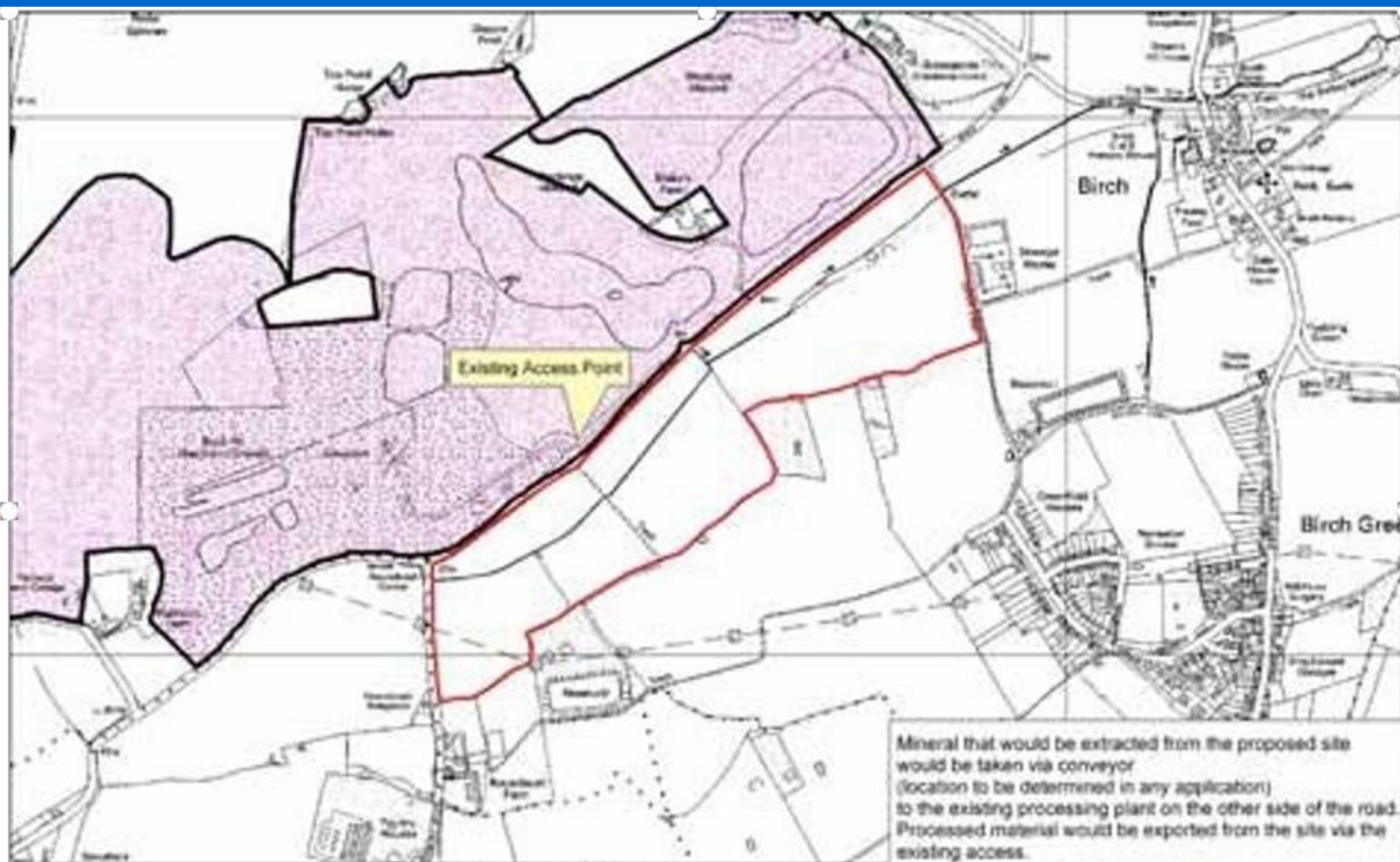


Birch Quarry
