Brief summary of the issue to be decided	<p>The current jointly commissioned contract with NELFT for the delivery of emotional wellbeing and mental health services to children and young people across Greater Essex is due to end 30th October 2020.</p> <p>Agreement to vary the contract from 1st November 2020 up until 1st April 2022 under Regulation 72(1)(b) of the Public Contract Regulations 2015 as procurement was delayed due to Partners in the Collaborative making decisions around their intended commissioning footprint and also as a result of the global pandemic.</p> <p>Agreement for Cllr John Spence, Cabinet Member for Health and Adults Social Care portfolio (including responsibility for all age mental health) to agree the contract variation to enable the continued delivery of the CYP EWMHS.</p>
