NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, the Essex County Council has temporarily introduced the following measures under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (the Act), in the interests of public safety and social distancing due to coronavirus.

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Monday to Saturday, 7am to 6pm

Exemptions for emergency, maintenance and refuse vehicles, and for goods vehicle loading and unloading

Butcher Row From its junction with Market Row to its junction with Market

Street

Cross Street From its junction with B184 Hill Street to its junction with Market

Row

King Street From its junction with B184 High Street to its junction with Market

Place

Market Hill From its junction with Church Street to its junction with Market

Place

Market Row From its junction with Cross Street to its junction with Market

Street

Market Place From its junctions with King Street, Market Hill and Market Street

for its entire length

All existing on-street parking, waiting and loading bays on the above mentioned roads are suspended during the hours that the Prohibition of Vehicles is in operation.

Installation of Disabled Badge Holders Only, Monday to Saturday, 7am to 6pm

Market Street On its east side, from a point approximately in line with the

northern kerbline of Market Row, south for 17 metres.



20mph Speed Limit

B184 High Street From its junction with Gold Street northwards to a point

approximately 5 metres south of its junction with Castle

Street

B184 East Street From its junction with Hill Street eastwards for 25 metres

Fairycroft Road From its junction with East Street southwards for 7 metres

Cross Street From its junction with B184 Hill Street to its junction with

Market Row

And the entire length of the following roads

Butcher Row, Church Street, Common Hill, Emson Close, George Street, Hill Street, King Street, Market Hill, Market Place, Market Row, Market Street

These traffic measures are undertaken under "the Act" and in conjunction with additional safety improvements as part of the response to the Covid-19 situation, designed to allow people more space to social distance as people move around the town centre. The Traffic measures under this 21 day notice may be extended for up to 18 months by virtue of an order made under section 14(1) of "the Act".

Temporary measures to facilitate these restrictions will be installed in the town centre from **6 July 2020**, to support non-essential retail business.
