Report of the budget meeting held on 14 February 2011 (For information)

Revenue Budget 2011/12, Precept and Council Tax

We have agreed to set our budget at £268.948m which requires a Council Tax of £132.12 for a band D property and are in the process of advising the 14 District and Unitary Councils of their individual precepts accordingly. The council tax is the same level as 2010/11.

Our Revenue Budget position is summarised in the Table below:-

With a combination of budget pressures to meet existing service commitments and a significant reduction in Government grant the Authority had to address a £17m budget shortfall for 2011/12. Moreover, the shortfall is forecast to increase to over £30m for 2012/13. In preparation for the task of re-shaping policing services in Essex in order to meet these new levels of affordability the Force has established a Reform Programme. The work of this Programme has identified savings and enabled a balanced budget to be set for 2011/12. The prime task is now to address the budget deficit for 2012/13. Work in this area is progressing as a matter of urgency in order to generate and implement savings whilst continuing to provide the best possible policing service to the community.

The Authority also agreed a capital programme for 2011/12 containing new projects totalling almost £5m. Similarly, the capital programme for 2012/13 and beyond will be revisited early during 2011/12 in order to ensure that investment in the estate, IT and the fleet complement the work of the Reform Programme.
