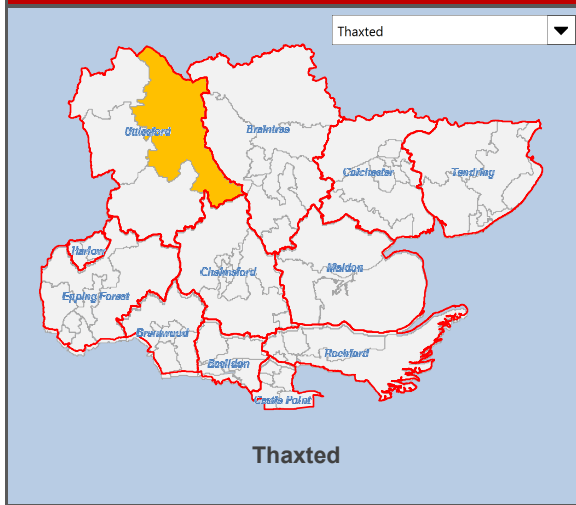
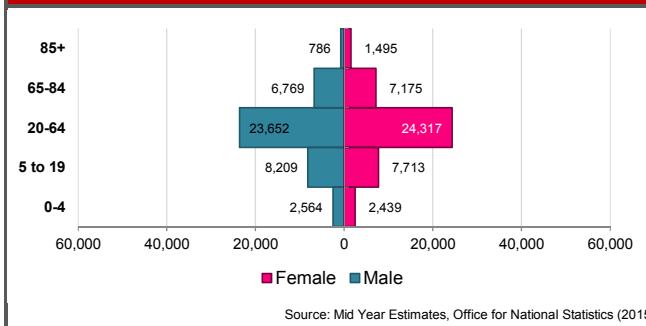

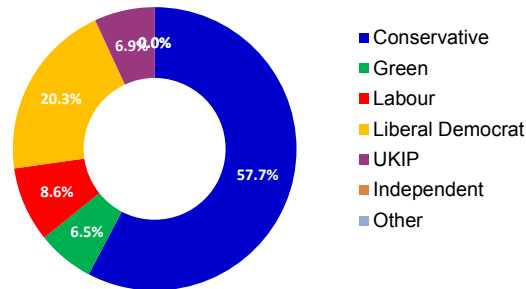
## DISTRICT LOCAL AUTHORITY PORTRAITS

### District: Uttlesford

Uttlesford is located in the north west corner of Essex. The district borders Hertfordshire to the west and Cambridgeshire to the north. It is the largest district in Essex, covering approximately 250 square miles, and is mainly rural in character with four market towns: Saffron Walden, Great Dunmow, Stansted Mountfitchet and Thaxted. Uttlesford is well served by major road, rail and air links; the M11 runs through the district and Stansted Airport is located within its boundaries. Due to its rural nature, however, there are accessibility issues for some without private transport especially in outlying villages.
